They Are Finally Installed!



For almost eighty years these old doors have protected the entry ways of the Martyrs' Shrine Church. Here on the left you can see one of the "old" doors. If one looks closely one can see the damage and wood rot on the bottom of the door. Much of

this damage was caused eighty years of winter snows and rains.

The good knights felt that the doors needed to be replaced and included them in their Shrine project for 2008. The doors were ordered and after a very long delay, one caused by the manufacturers of the "new" doors, the Shrine Church doors are now installed. They are fine, sturdy, solid wood core doors that will no doubt last for many years to come.
